Format Scramble - All players hit from the tee, the team then selects the best shot. Each player then hits from that spot (within a club length not closer to the pin). Play continues in this manner until the ball is holed out. If playing with less than 4 players, rotate through each player to hit for the missing player – Player A hits an extra shot, then Player B hits the next extra shot.

Tees Men – White Tees / Ladies – Red Tees

Scoring Team Captain will record the team's (actual) score on each hole, and after your round is completed, your scorecard must be signed by the captain and attested by another team member. Maximum score for any hole will be double-bogey.

Putting Once a ball is on the green there will be an automatic two-putt. This means the team can not three-putt. Each member takes one putt. If the ball is holed the stroke counts. If all four players miss their first putt the second is deemed to have been holed.

Tee Shots Two Tee Shots are required from each team member, and they need to be recorded on your scorecard.

Rules Winter rules will apply "Through the Green". The ball selected to play may be lifted, cleaned and placed within one club length of its original position – no nearer the hole. The position of the ball must be marked before lifting. In no case shall a ball on the fringe of the green be improved to lie on the green. If ball selected is in a bunker or hazard, the player who hit it must hit first as it lies, and then other players will place within one club length no nearer the hole but within the hazard or bunker (bunker may be raked before placing). A ball selected to be played from the rough must be played from the rough.

Pace of Play Any team that falls more than one hole behind will be given a warning to close the gap within the next two holes. The second warning will result in the team being asked to move forward to the next tee and taking a double par score on the hole they were playing. This will be enforced by the Anchorage Golf Course Marshals.

Ties Teams that tie for trophies and prizes will play off by matching cards from hole #18 backwards using the team's gross score. "Through the green" is the whole area of the course except: a) The teeing ground and putting green of the hole being played; and b) All hazards on the course.

Volunteers of America Alaska's **YOUTH PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROJECT** will serve Anchorage's most vulnerable youth and young adults.

We are using research-based services to bring hope to the lives of young adults who are facing the most extreme of circumstances—homelessness, and other risk factors such as trauma, exploitation, and mental health and substance abuse challenges.

"This program represents hope. Hope that with timely intervention, these young adults who are struggling with mental health and addictions do not end up in the homeless system for decades or worse."

Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) is an Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) that pairs affordable housing with support services and addresses chronic homelessness and instability of those living on the street and who are most vulnerable and most likely to die without intervention.

While there is a significant body of research around the effectiveness of PSH, nationally, this has not been done with youths or transition-aged youths. Volunteers of America Alaska will be using PSH as a critical piece of the overall strategy to end youth homelessness in our state.
